Belgian Brain Initiative Phase III

The achievements of Phase I in 2023 and Phase II in 2024 of the Belgian Brain Plan, realized through the collaboration with the French, German, and Greek Brain Councils to establish an AISBL European Brain Data Hub, motivated us to persist in this endeavor.

This phase III, with a budget of €60,000 for 2025, seeks to evaluate the data sharing mechanism developed in the preceding phases under real-world conditions.





The BBC is collaborating with the National Order of Physicians to host a seminar on April 1, 2025.






The BBC endorses and aligns itself with the statement issued by Alzheimer's Association Europe in reaction to the EMA's unfavorable report on lecanemab.
