



COVID LONG – FOLLOW–UP

Sciensano has just published a COVIMPACT study which estimated that between 30 April 2021 and 20 June 2021 47% of participants infected with COVID-19 suffer from LONG COVID (i.e. 3 months after infection). We illustrate it here with the figure 2 the distribution of symptoms 3 months after the infection



This very complete table of symptoms is comparable to the KCE report (included in our October newsletter)² and validates the timeliness of our WEBINAR on the 11 September COVID LONG already viewed over 800 times on YouTube.³
